1. Matters to be submitted for bidding

(1) Project name

20th Asian Games Aichi-Nagoya 2026 Host Broadcaster's Work

(2) Project specifications, etc.

The specifications, etc., shall be as indicated in the bidding instructions.

(3) Contract term

From the date of the conclusion of the contract to Friday, December 18, 2026

(4) Place of performance (delivery)

The location shall be as indicated in the bidding instructions.

- (5) Bidding method, etc.
 - A. This bidding shall be conducted by the "electronic bidding system (goods, etc.)" (hereinafter referred to as the "electronic bidding system"), which is a subsystem of the Aichi e-Procurement Joint System (goods, etc.). In principle, paper or e-mail bidding will not be accepted. However, paper or e-mail bids will be accepted if Application for approval of participation in a paper or e-mail bidding is submitted.
 - B. Detailed bidding procedures shall be in accordance with the Implementation Guidelines of Electronic Bidding for goods, etc.
 - C. The amount indicated in the bidding document plus an amount equivalent to 10/100 of the said amount shall be the contract price.

The bidder shall submit the bidding document in an amount equivalent to 100/110 of the desired contract price.

This procedure for the bidding document is the same for both taxable companies and tax-exempt companies with respect to the consumption tax and local consumption tax.

2. Qualifications for competitive bidding

Those qualified to participate in this bidding shall meet the following requirements.

Applications may be submitted solely by a single company or by a joint venture, consortium, etc. (hereinafter referred to as the " joint venture, etc."). However, a single company may not participate in more than one joint venture, etc., or participate in a bidding process as a sole bidder while participating in a joint venture, etc.

In the case of a joint venture, etc., the representative of the joint venture, etc. must meet the requirements in (1) through (8). All members except the representative must meet (2) through (8).

The requirement in (9) must be met by the representative of the joint venture, etc. or by any of its members other than the representative.

(1) The bidder is listed in the "Details (Minor Category) 01. Film and other productions" in "Business Category (Medium Category) 03. Film production, advertising and events" of "Business (Major Category) 03. Provision of Services" in the AINAGOC Bidding Qualification List for the manufacture of goods, etc. for 2024 and 2025 fiscal year.

In addition, parties who wish to participate in the bidding process but are not registered above shall be checked to determine if (1) is met by submitting the Bidding Qualification Application Form, certificate of registered matters and certificate of tax payment.

- (2) The bidder has not fallen under any of the items of Article 167-4, Paragraph 1 and Paragraph 2 of the Local Autonomy Law Enforcement Order (Cabinet Order No. 16 of 1947) (including the cases where it is applied mutatis mutandis under Article 167-11, Paragraph 1 of the same Order).
- (3) The bidder has not been filed a petition for commencement of reorganization proceedings under the Corporate Reorganization Law (Law No. 154 of 2002) (excluding those who have been registered or certified for bidding qualifications listed in 1 after the decision to commence reorganization proceedings under the same law).
- (4) The bidder has not been filed a petition for commencement of rehabilitation proceedings under the Civil Rehabilitation Law (Law No. 225 of 1999) (excluding

those who have been registered or certified for bidding qualifications listed in 1 after the decision to commence rehabilitation proceedings under the same law).

- (5) The bidder has not been suspended as a nominated bidder by AINAGOC during the period from the date of public notice to the determination of the successful bidder.
- (6) The bidder has not been suspended as a nominated bidder by Aichi Prefecture or Nagoya City based on the "Guidelines for the Handling of Suspension of Nominations for Aichi Prefecture Accounting Bureau," "Guidelines for the Handling of Suspension of Nominations for Aichi Prefecture Construction Work, etc." and "Nagoya City Outline for Suspension of Nominations" during the period from the date of public notice to the determination of the successful bidder. However, only those with a start date prior to May 19, 2024.
- (7) The bidder has not been subject to exclusion measures based on the "Agreement on the Exclusion of Gangster Organizations from Affairs and Business Conducted by Aichi Prefecture" (concluded by the Governor of Aichi Prefecture and the Chief of Aichi Prefectural Police Headquarters on June 29, 2012) during the period from the date of public notice to the decision on the successful bidder. We don't have a period of the exclusion measures based on the "Administrative Procedures for the Elimination of Gangster Organizations from Procurement Contracts Conducted by Aichi Prefecture". We have not been subject to the exclusion measures based on the "Agreement on the Exclusion of Entities Affiliated with Gangster Organizations from Procurement Contracts by Nagoya City" (concluded by the Mayor of Nagoya City and the Chief of Aichi Prefectural Police Headquarters on January 28, 2008). We don't have a period of the exclusion measures based on the "Handling Guidelines for the Exclusion of Gangsters-Related Businesspersons from Procurement Contracts, etc. Conducted by Nagoya City" (19 Zaikei No. 103).
- (8) The bidder has not failed to pay the national and local taxes.
- (9) The bidder has a track record of having been commissioned by the organizer or organizing committee as a prime contractor (including those who are members of a joint venture, etc.) to undertake and provide host broadcaster work, such as international feed production and distribution, for the multi-sport events, including

Aquatics, Athletics and Gymnastics, for events like the Olympic Games and Asian Games since April 2015, in which more than 30 countries and regions participated.

The electronic bidding system operates from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on days other than Sundays, Saturdays, holidays stipulated in the Law Concerning National Holidays (Law No. 178 of 1948), and December 29 through January 3 of the following year.

(2) Bidding period

From 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, March 18, 2025 to 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, April 1, 2025 (Japanese Standard Time (GMT+9:00))

In case of paper or email bid participation, the bidding document and the centralized document must be submitted within the above-mentioned period by bringing, mailing or e-mailing at the location indicated in 3(4). If you bring documents, they shall be submitted only between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and national holidays.

(3) Date, time and place of bid opening

4. Others

(1) Language used in the contract procedure

English or Japanese shall be the language used for the contract procedure. All documents shall be submitted to AINAGOC in English or Japanese. If this document is translated, the English version shall have priority.

(2) Contractual currency

The contractual currency shall be limited to the currency of Japan.

(3) Time used in the contract procedure

Japanese Standard Time (GMT+9:00) shall be adopted.

(4) Bid deposit

Those who intend to participate in the bidding shall comply with Article 7, Paragraph (3) of the Aichi-Nagoya Asian Games and Asian Para Games Organizing Committee Contract Regulations (hereinafter referred to as the "Contract Regulations") and pay a bid deposit (including a security in lieu of bid deposit as provided in Article 7, Paragraph (2) of the Contract Regulations) in the amount of more than 5/100 of the estimated amount by the bid opening date. However, if a bidder who intends to participate in the bidding falls under Article 8 of the Contract Regulations, the bid deposit shall be exempted in whole or in part.

(5) Invalidation of bids

In accordance with Article 6 of the Contract Regulations, bids that fall under within the relevant clause and bids made using the card fraudulently will be considered invalid.

(6) Whether or not a written contract is required

(7) How to prepare a contract

An electromagnetic record of the contents of the contract (hereinafter referred to as the "electronic contract") is created using the electronic contract service. If an electronic contract is not feasible, a paper contract shall be prepared.

(8) Matters required of competitive bidders

A person who wishes to participate in the bidding shall submit the "Application for Confirmation of Qualification for Participation in Competitive Bidding" and documents, etc. proving that the party has a track record of performance under contract (listed in the bidding instruction) (hereinafter referred to as the "Application for Confirmation, etc.").

Must be submitted via the electronic bidding system by 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, March 12, 2025 (Japanese Standard Time (GMT+9:00)). However, applicants who wish to submit paper or e-mail bids may do so by bringing, mailing or e-mailing within the submission deadline.

In addition, the applicant must respond to any requests for explanations regarding the submitted documents. As a result of examination of the submitted Application for Confirmation, etc., only those who are deemed capable of performing the work will be allowed to participate.

(9) Method of determining the successful bidder

The successful bidder will be the one who submitted the lowest valid bid within the limits of the estimated price prepared in accordance with Article 11 of the Contract Regulations.

(10) Others

Details will depend on the bidding instructions.
